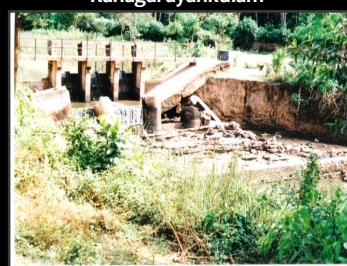

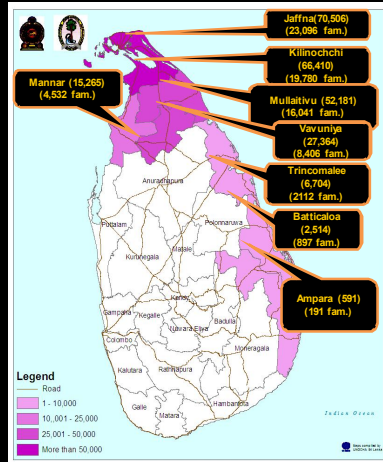

Provision of Relief Packages to the Re-settlers

- Six months dry rations
- Non food relief items (NFRI)
- Set of kitchen utensils
- Shelter grant of Rs. 25,000/-
- Roofing sheets (12 Nos.)
- Cement (8 bags per family)
- Agricultural tool kits
- Provision of seed paddy 2 bushels per acre per family for 2 acres
- Provision of fertilizer
- Land preparation cost of Rs. 4000/- per acre
- Provision of basic transport facilities

Re-settlement Process - Steps to life

Infrastructure

The following activities were undertaken:

Rehabilitation of access roads, restoration of power supply, rehabilitation of major and minor tanks, canals and culverts, rehabilitation and re-commissioning of irrigation facilities.

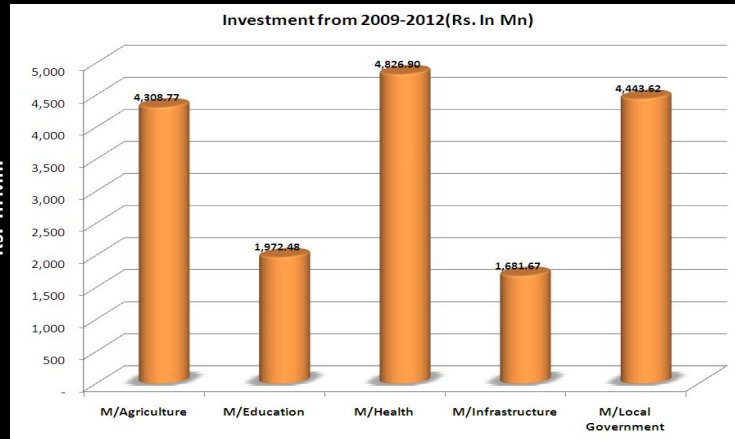

Sectoral Contribution for "Vadakkinn Vasantham" Development Programme for the period from 2009 - 2012

- A sum of Rs.17,233.44 Mn has been invested for the resettled areas to develop livelihood and basic infrastructure facilities for the resettled people



- All these efforts contributed to the resettlers for their day to day livelihood activities and fulfill their needs.

Provincial Contribution to the National Economy

- The GDP growth rate was highest in the province at 27.1 % in 2011
- GDP share 3.7% to the national GDP in 2011.
- The Agriculture, including Fisheries and Animal husbandry which is the mainstay of the economy has shown positive growth after 2009
- The agricultural sector contributed 24.2 % of GDP composition to the provincial economy in 2011.

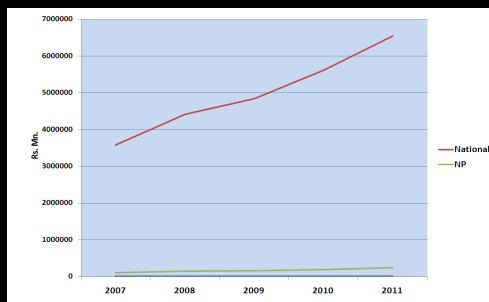
- Paddy production in the Northern Province in the year 2011 and 2012 had recorded highest yield in the country

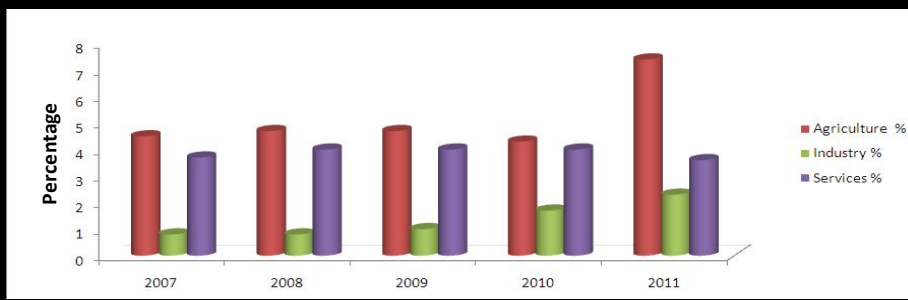



Education Support Provided for University Students and Ex-Combatants Governor's Special Scheme – 2008/2009

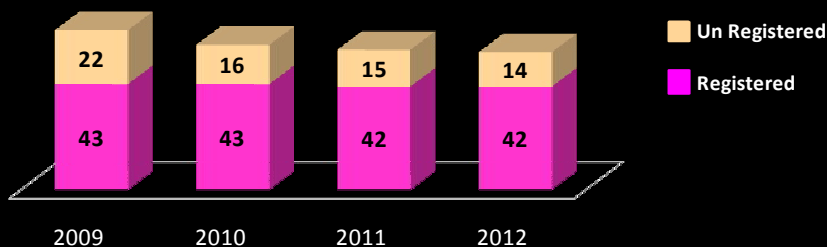
- The objective of this scheme, IDP students returning from war zone have allowed to continue their studies in the Universities after going through the government procedures applicable to IDPs and Ex- Combatants due to the displacement .
- This scheme started in 2010
- Out of 424 students, 189 students were selected for this scheme.
- Each of these students get assistance for the university Academic year up to completion of the course studies.
- The following criteria have been recommended for identification.
 - Displaced Students - Rs.2,000/-
 - Students lost their breadwinners - Rs.3,500/-
 - Students of below family income of Rs.6,000/- - Rs.5,000/-
 - Married Students - Rs.6,500/-
- Assistance Given under the scheme.
 - In 2010 - 189 Students (Rs.7.98 Mn)
 - In 2011 - 180 Students (Rs.7.63 Mn)
 - In 2012 - 103 Students (Rs.3.97 Mn)

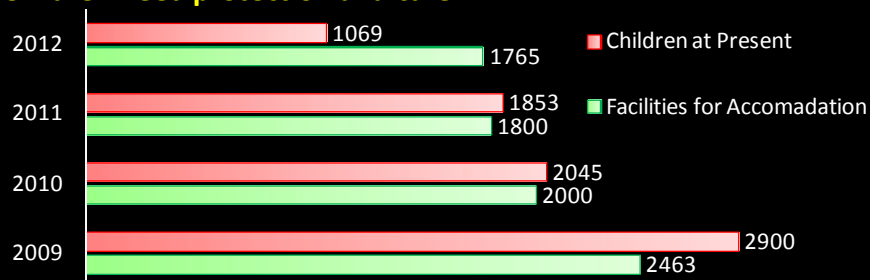

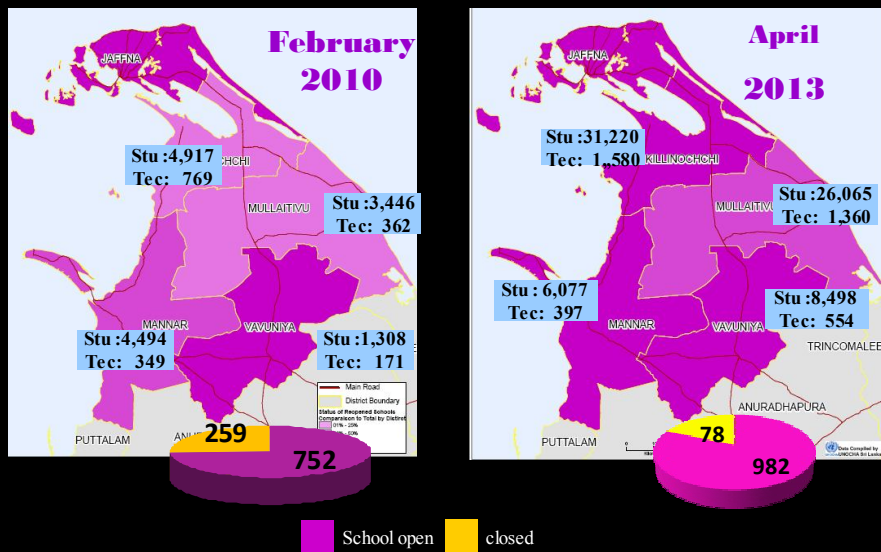

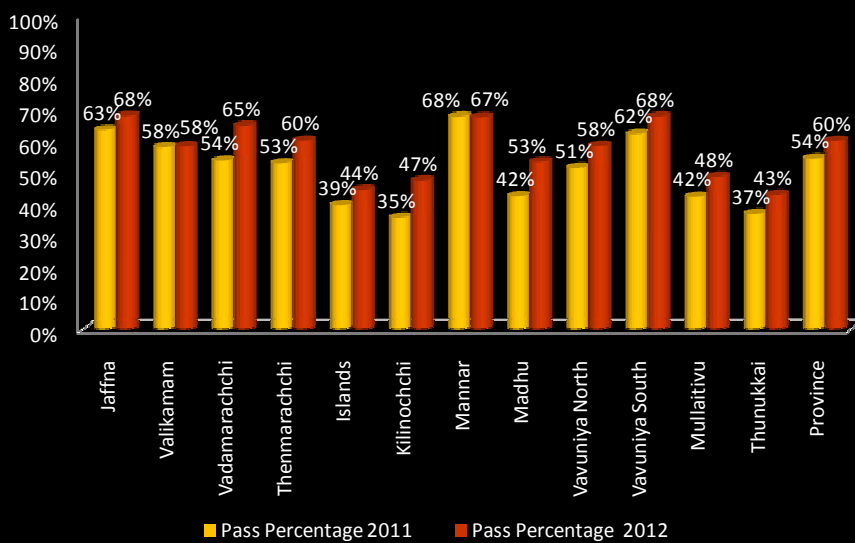

- 1,642 pre schools with 2,890 teachers and 48,252 children.
- Provincial Advisory Committee, Zonal Committee, Divisional Committee, Preschool Management Committee were formed.
- 1,847 Preschool Teachers got Monthly Allowances.
- 840 Preschool Teachers were trained on the In Service Training.
- Infrastructure Facilities were provided for 99 Preschools.

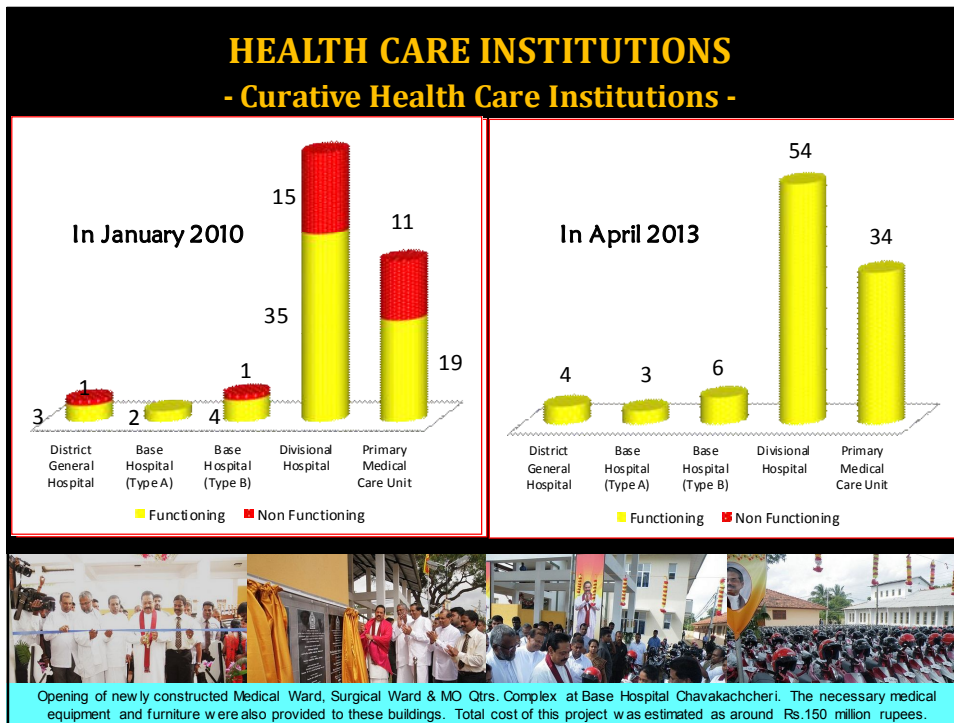

HEALTH - ACHIEVEMENTS UNDER "VADAKKIN VASANTHAM"


- Rs. 4,814 Mn to improve the Health Sector during the period of 2009 - 2012.
- 237 Major health institutions were re-constructed or renovated (Rs. 2,250 Mn).
- Nearly Rs.1,300 Mn worth medical equipment provided to all hospitals in the NP including resettlement areas.
- Most of quarters for MOs, NOs & other staff reconstructed at a cost of Rs. 500 Mn.
- 31 nos. of Ambulance, 8 nos. of single cab, 3 nos. of mobile dental vehicle, 2 nos. of mobile spraying unit, 2 nos. mental health vehicle, a 52-seated bus, a drug lorry, an ambulance boat, 30 motorbikes, 150 Scooty & 385 bicycles and 8 generators also supplied to resettlement areas. (Rs.450Mn)

HEALTH - ACHIEVEMENTS UNDER "VADAKKIN VASANTHAM"

- Newly constructed Medical Ward, Surgical Ward & MO Qtrs. Complex at Base Hospital Chavakachcheri opened. Medical equipment and furniture were also provided. Total cost of this project was estimated as around Rs.150 Mn. On the same day Under the Japanese Social Development Fund project 100 midwives received motorbikes and 285 Community Health Facilitators received bicycle to implement the nutrition Improvement in Northern Province.
- In DGH Mannar a Special Care Baby Unit constructed & equipped at a cost of Rs. 25 Mn. A Paediatric ward complex in DH Adampan & MOH Office Adampan also were constructed at a cost of Rs. 40 Mn.
- A foundation stone for a ward complex in Mulankavil Base Hospital & Oddusuddan Divisional hospital was laid down (Rs.100 Mn.)

- 163 Nursing officers & 202 midwives appointed.
- 3 ambulances to Mullaitivu General Hospital, Mallavi Base Hospital and Periyapandivirichan Divisional Hospital respectively. The lorry was distributed to Kilinochchi RDHS Office
- A Bio Medical Engineering & Pathology unit were constructed at DGH (Rs. 27 Mn)
- The office complex of the Regional Director of Health Services, Kilinochchi constructed & equipped at a cost of Rs. 22 Mn.
- The newly built RDHS Office, Mullaitivu was constructed at a cost of Rs. 39 Mn.
- A gully sucker tractor and 10 televisions sets distributed to the RDHS, Mullaitivu.



HEALTH - ACHIEVEMENTS UNDER "VADAKKIN VASANTHAM"

- GoSL initiated local level nutrition intervention programme with the support of Japan Social Development Fund (JSDF). Ministry of Health & IM implements this project with the objective of reducing malnutrition level among lactating mothers, pregnant mothers and below 2 years children (Rs. 300 Mn.).
- "JEEVAPOSHA" distributed about 16,000 undernourished people in Kilinochchi, Mullaitivu, Mannar & Vavuniya districts and 4 MOH divisions in Jaffna district.
- Construction of four storied 200 bedded ward complex at District General Hospital Vavuniya has been started (Rs. 187 Mn.).
- Ministry of Economic Development has supplied a CT scanner to DGH Vavuniya at the cost of Rs. 56 Mn.

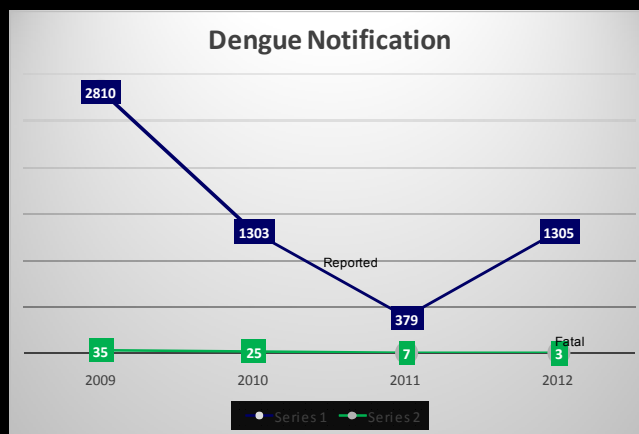
His Excellency the President Mahinda Rajapaksa declared open **Multi - facility Buildings complex at the Teaching Hospital, Jaffna**. The building complex was constructed at the cost of 2600 million rupees. The complex consist of 10 operation theaters, two Intensive Care Units with 20 beds, a Central Supply and Sterilization Unit, a Central Laboratory, a Disease Analyzing Unit, and advanced medical equipment. 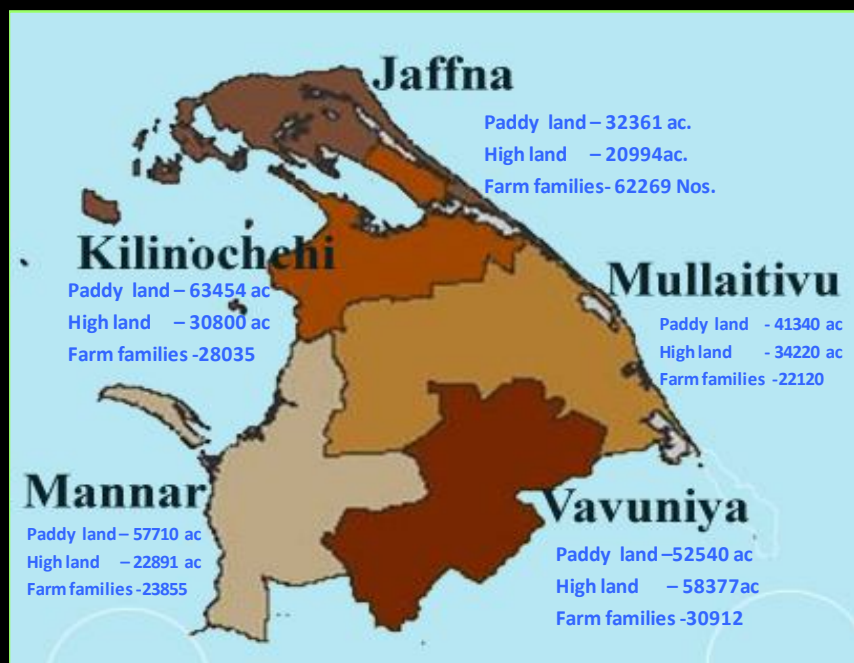

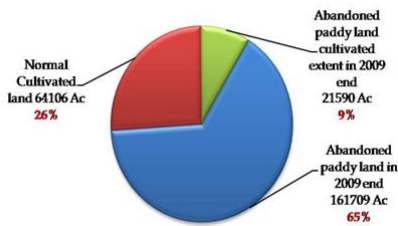

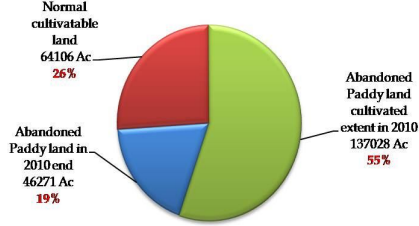

Abandoned Paddy land at the end of the year 2009



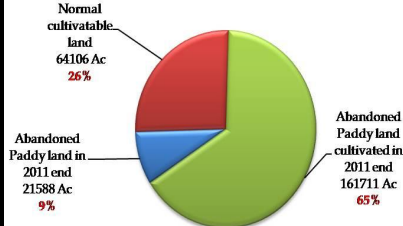

Abandoned Paddy land at the end of the year 2010



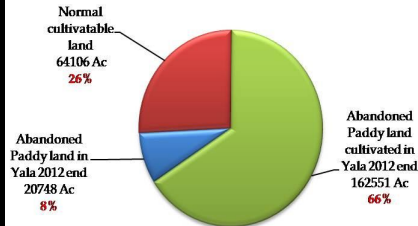

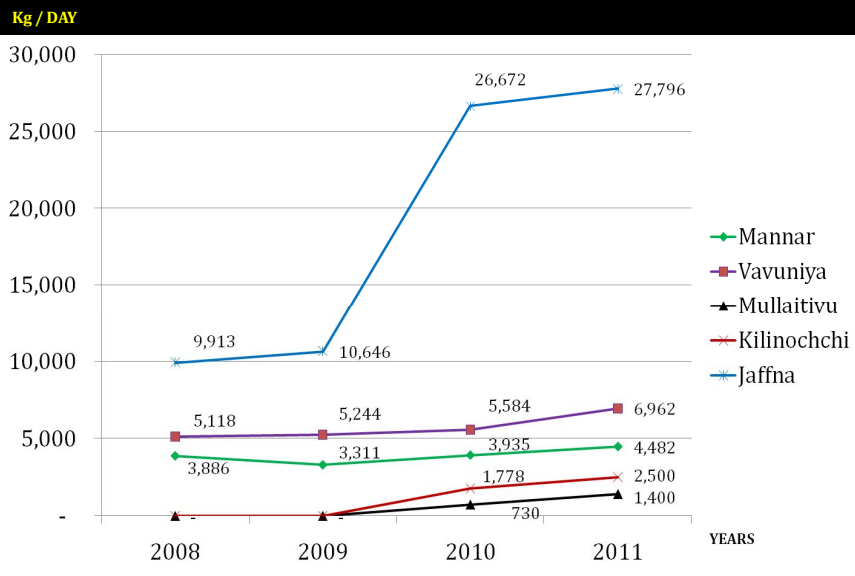

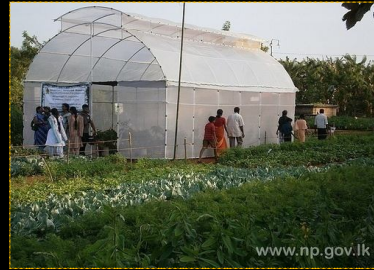
